

Report: Justice Tech for All How Technology can Ethically Disrupt the US Justice System (Village Capital & AmFam Institute 2021)

From the report: In September 2020, Village Capital and the AmFam Institute convened a summit on justice tech to discuss how to move forward in redefining criminal and civil justice tech from an ethical, human-centered perspective. grassroots activists, foundation leaders, startup founders, legal experts and venture capitalists.
