

Open to the Public - 2024 How Law Libraries are Serving Self-Represented Litigants Across the Country




The Law Librarians' Working Group of the Self-Represented Litigation Network with the American Association of Law Libraries Government Law Libraries Special Interest Section Best A2J Practices Committee surveyed law libraries about their services to the self-represented litigant, including self-help programs.
